**DATE: Saturday October 20<sup>th</sup> 8:00 am to 4:00 pm (Day 1)**


**Sunday October 21<sup>st</sup> 1:00 pm to 4:00 pm (Day 2)**

### **What kind of work will we be doing?**

*After the new playground equipment is installed by our contractor Playgrounds R Us, CTK volunteers will install water drainage pipes and distribute Engineered Wood Fiber (EWF); a lightweight, shredded, rubber-like material. A special felt material will also be placed around the playground equipment footings. Volunteers will shovel/pitchfork the EWF into wheelbarrows and spread the EWF over the ground.*

### **Why are we doing this work?**

*By putting in some “sweat equity”, CTK will save nearly \$10,000 on the overall cost of the playground project. It also gives us an opportunity to contribute to the enhancement of our school as a community.*

### **How many people are needed to get the job done?**

*We need at least 20 people to complete the job, so everyone please consider coming out and pitching in. The more people, the easier and quicker the job can get done!*

*Yes, however for safety and liability reasons children will not be able to help with the playground work. The playground area will be off limits and secured with fencing until the project is fully completed. To keep kids occupied the school gym will be open and tables and chairs will be set up with craft supplies and activities to keep kids occupied. A parent volunteer will provide supervision. The canteen will be open serving refreshments throughout the day and a hotdog lunch for volunteers and their kids will be provided.*

- *Shovels*
- *Rakes*
- *Pitch Forks*
- *Wheel Barrows*
- *Construction Knives (for cutting the drains and felt)*
